A 32 bar Jig for 5 couples

Bars

1-8 $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples lead down the middle for three, back up to the top, cross over and cast off one place on opposite sides. $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ couples step up on bars 3 and 4

9-12 All 5 couples, turn by the right hand

13-16 All 5 couples, turn by the left hand

17-24 $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples petronella to finish on own sides.

25-32 $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ couples and, at the same time, $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ couples poussette. Set is now $2,4,1,5,3$.

Repeat with new 1 st and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples.
