## STAIRCASE IN STYRIA

A 40 bar reel for 5 couples in a 5 couple longwise set devised by Margaret Gray  
NB—No stepping up or down until bar 27

- 1-8 With 1st & 3rd ladies dancing IN FRONT of their partners, first couple dance right hands across with second man, WHILE third couple dance right hands across with fourth man. First couple dance left hands across with second lady, WHILE 3rd couple dance left hands across with fourth lady.
- 9-16 First couple dance right hands across with fourth man, WHILE third couple dance right hands across with fifth man. First couple dance left hands across with fourth lady, WHILE third couple dance left hands across with fifth lady, finishing with first and third couples facing out the ladies' side, man behind his partner, first couple below fourth couple, third couple below fifth couple.
- 17-24 First and third couples dance out the ladies' side, cast up one place, cross to the men's side, cast up one place, and dance back to original places.  
(NB No stepping up or down required so far)
- 25-32 First couple only cross giving right hand, cast off one place (Second couple step up), and first couple, followed by third couple dance up and cast, first couple to third place (opposite sides), third couple to second place.
- 33-40 First couple cross giving right hand, cast off one place (Fourth couple step up), and first couple, followed by fifth couple dance up and cast round fourth couple, first couple to fifth place, fifth couple to fourth place, finishing 2,3,4,5,1.

Built in 1499 by Emperor Maximilian I, Duke of Styria, in Graz. a double-spiral staircase - two flights of staircases, running in opposite directions, join for some steps on each floor, separate again, join again... The architectural masterpiece has often been interpreted as a symbol of eternity. Graz people call it the "stairs of reconciliation" - if you go separate ways, you will reunite.
